- Where, when, for whom? This invitation is primarily for children from birth to seven months.
- Baby-Singing, what on earth is that? Of course infants cannot sing church songs, but they can take in the sound of the voice and the atmosphere. Text and melody can settle into their subconscious and develop into a life-long joy.

Third page:

Today we know that music has great importance for infants, and even for unborn children. Recent research from work with newborns and music shows the following:

- Hearing is fully developed in unborn babies already from the 24th week.
- Newborns can distinguish the voice of their mother from other voices.
- Singing reinforces the emotional development and imagination of the child.
- Singing stimulate language and motor development of the child.
- Singing is a means of communication which crosses over boundaries of culture, gender, and age.
- Singing is the first step in the musical development of the child.
- Singing moves one and brings about movement.
- Singing is an important part of culture.

You need no musical background to participate.

Your child loves your voice.

There will be an organist and song leader present to play and to sing with you.

A good song cleanses the heart.

Schedule of Baby-Singing:

- Greeting
- Ring triangle 3 x 3 times
- Sunday school children's song
- 3 hymns
- Active component: movement, dance (along with a hymn)
- Longer hymn
- Evening Lullaby
- Song of Blessing
- Goodnight Song
- Lord's Prayer
- Piece of Organ Music (all lie on mattresses)
- During or after the organ music: blow soap bubbles

Place: right on the floor (on mattresses) in the sanctuary (!) around the altar, or seated on chairs.

Suggestion: Rock your baby in bed sheets
